Acceptable in 2014:
Tennessee Drivers License (current or expired)
Tennessee Handgun Permit
U. S. Passport (current or expired)
U. S. Military photo ID, including a Veteran Identification Card
Tennessee Department of Safety ID
Photo ID issued by the Federal or Tennessee State Government, such as an employee ID from the U. S. Department of Energy with your photo

Not Acceptable are student ID's or photo ID's not issued by the Federal or Tennessee government, such as your discount club or bank card with your photo

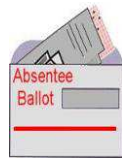

BECOME A POLL WORKER



APPLICATION TO SERVE AS AN ELECTION OFFICIAL ON ELECTION DAY

(Commissioners meet between the 60th and 30th day before an election to appoint officials for the county's twenty precincts. If you are appointed, you will be notified of your appointment and of the training opportunities provided. Training is mandatory.)

✓ **I am a registered voter in Warren County**

(only registered voters are eligible to serve, with the exception of seventeen year old high school students)

✓ **I am not an employee of a Federal, State, County or Municipal Governmental Agency**

✓ **I am willing to work from 7 a.m. until dismissed by the Officer of Election, usually around 8 p.m. on Election Day.**

✓ **I am willing to attend a training session which will inform and prepare me for my duties as an Election Official.**

BY MAIL VOTING (NO PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR ABSENTEE VOTERS)

The following voters may request a ballot be mailed to them :

- Military and Civilians residing overseas (the Federal MOVE Act allows us to email ballots to UOCAVA voters)
- Holders of Commercial Drivers License (must provide copy of CDL)
- Over 60 years of age
- Out of the county during all hours of Early Voting and on Election Day
- Students or spouse of students enrolled in a college or university in Tennessee
- Hospitalized voters
- State or Federal Jurors
- Observers of a Religious Holiday
- Voters on the Permanent Absentee Register (these voters have a Physician's Statement on file and have been placed on this list. An application is automatically mailed.)

If your request for ballot contains ALL the following information it may be treated as an actual application:

1. Name
2. Date of Birth
3. Social Security Number
4. Address in Warren County
5. Reason for requesting ballot by mail
6. If primaries are being held, which party—Democratic or Republican—is your preference
7. Address ballot should be mailed, if different from residence address
8. VOTER'S SIGNATURE

Note: Voters registering by mail must vote in person the first time they vote, either early or at the polls on Election Day.

EARLY VOTING (PHOTO ID REQUIRED)

ANY REGISTERED VOTER IN WARREN COUNTY MAY VOTE EARLY WITHOUT A REASON. VOTING IS AT THE REAR OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING. SAMPLE BALLOT AND HOURS OF VOTING ARE PUBLISHED IN THE SOUTHERN STANDARD AT LEAST 25 DAYS BEFORE EVERY ELECTION. A SAMPLE BALLOT MAY ALSO BE FOUND ON OUR WEBSITE, warrentnelections.com
