2010 Elections

May 4 -- County Republican and Democratic Party Primaries for local offices, to include County Executive, County Commissioner, Trustee, Sheriff, Circuit Court Clerk, County Clerk, Register of Deeds, Superintendent of Roads and Constable

August 5 -- County General Election for local offices including School Board (odd-numbered districts) in conjunction with State and Federal Primaries for US Congress, Tennessee Governor and State House of Representatives

November 2-- State and Federal General Elections for those candidates nominated in the August Primaries as well as McMinnville and Morrison Municipal Elections

**Sample Ballots for each election will be posted on our website as soon as they become available*

Recent Changes

Congress passed the Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment (MOVE) Act in October 2009. The Act changed the length of time that an FPCA (Form 76) is valid. ***If you submitted an FPCA prior to January 1, 2010, you must submit a new form for this year's elections.*** You may mail, fax, or EMAIL your form to the Warren County Election Commission Office. *Note that if you are emailing the (FPCA) the form must be completed, signed, then scanned and attached to an email.* A simple email requesting the information is not sufficient to serve as an application for ballots.

For FPCA's already received, we mail out ballots at least by the 45th day before any election.

We must receive your request no later than seven days before any election and voted ballots must be returned by postal mail by the close of polls—7:00 p.m. CST—on Election Day. Actual ballots cannot be returned to us by fax or email because of the secrecy issues involved.

Tennessee requires that you provide your political party preference to vote in party primaries. If you want to vote in either the May 4 or August 5 primaries, please make sure you indicate your preference in the appropriate space on the FPCA!
